



Grinch Raw Edge

Machine Embroidery Applique Instructions

Free design File is supplied For Personal Use Only—Grinch Image is trademarked

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Description: This design was created to show raw edge applique with felt. It is 5.5 X 4.65 inches. Ensure you are using a correct size hoop for your machine. Multiple machine file types are included in the zip file. The design colors once loaded into your machine may look different than the finished picture due to the way your embroidery machine reads the file. This is normal. Please follow along with these instructions to ensure correct color changes. This is an ***intensive*** applique design with frequent hoop removal and trimming of the body parts. If the white applique parts are not desired to be embroidered, the design may be finished at the end of the black details and your choice of fluff trim can be sewn on by hand or sewing machine. Cutting out all fabric pieces before you begin and labeling them will make it an easier process as stitching time is minimal. Multiple color changes have been digitized to allow your machine to stop at each required interval.

Tools required

5x7 hoop, scissors or rotary cutter, ruler for cutting and measuring, applique scissors, tear away stabilizer.
OPTIONAL Brass Brush or Chenille Brush for fluffing edges. Lint Roller for final cleanup

Materials required

Thread: Green 5500, Red 1720, Yellow 0600, Black 0020 and White 0015. Isacord thread was used in the design.
Use comparative colors as needed if you don't have the Isacord brand.

Fleece Remnants: Red, Lime Green, White

Desired BASE Material to stitch design to. Would work well on pillows, bags, Christmas signs with the addition of your Text



Material Cuts:

Red

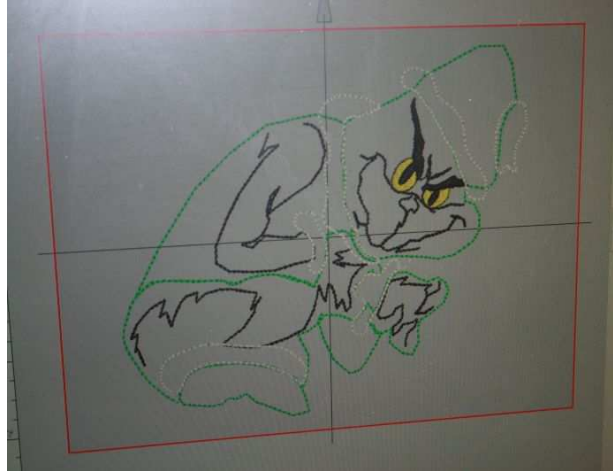
Piece A (Jacket) 3.5x3.5 Piece B (Arm) 1.5x1.5; Piece C (Shoe) 1.5x2.5; Piece D (Hat) 2X2.5

Green

Piece E (Hand) 2x2; Piece F (Leg) 4.5x3.5; Piece G (Face) 3.5x3.5

White

Piece H (Shoe Fluff) 1.5x3; Piece I (Arm Fluff) 1.5x2; Piece J (Sleeve fluff) 1x1;
Piece K (Neck Fluff) 1.5x3; Piece L (Hat Fluff) 1x3; Piece M (Pom Pom) 1x1.5

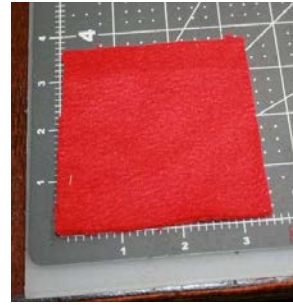


The design will stitch a placement stitch for each body part. After this happens, place the fleece over the sewn area and a triple stitch will tack it down. Remove the hoop after each tack down and trim around the fabric. No need to be precise as the raw edges will not ravel and can be fluffed up after the design completes. Use a generous 1/8 inch trimmed area around each applique.

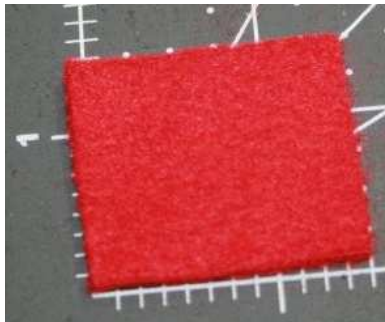


Hoop base material and tear away stabilizer

Steps 1 and 2– Red Thread—Placement stitch, Use Piece A, Tack down, Trim around fabric



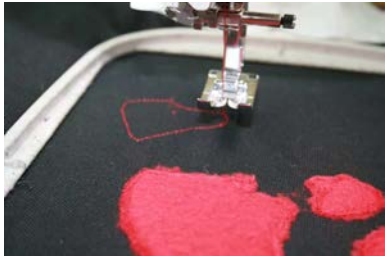
Steps 3 and 4– Red Thread—Placement stitch, Use Piece B, Tack down, Trim around fabric



Steps 5 and 6– Red Thread—Placement stitch, Use Piece C, Tack down, Trim around fabric



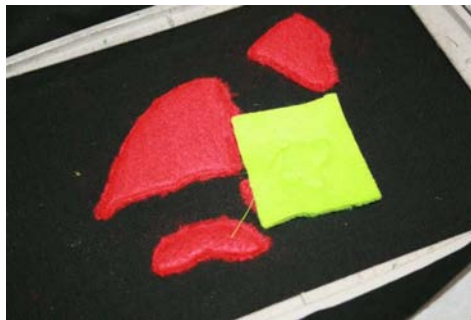
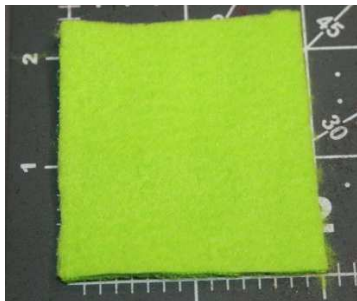
Steps 7 and 8— Red Thread—Placement stitch, Use Piece D, Tack down, Trim around fabric



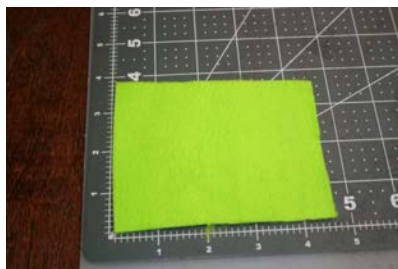
Change Thread Color To Green



Steps 9 and 10— Green Thread—Placement stitch, Use Piece E, Tack down, Trim around fabric



Steps 11 and 12— Green Thread—Placement stitch, Use Piece F, Tack down, Trim around fabric



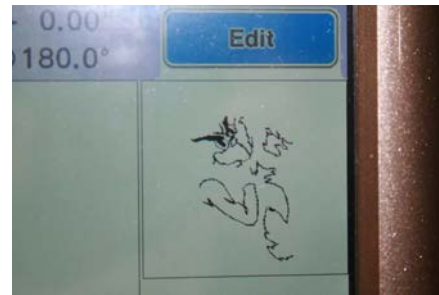
Steps 13 and 14— Green Thread—Placement stitch, Use Piece G, Tack down, Trim around fabric



Change Thread Color To Yellow to stitch eyes Step 15



Change Thread Color To Black to Stitch details Step 16



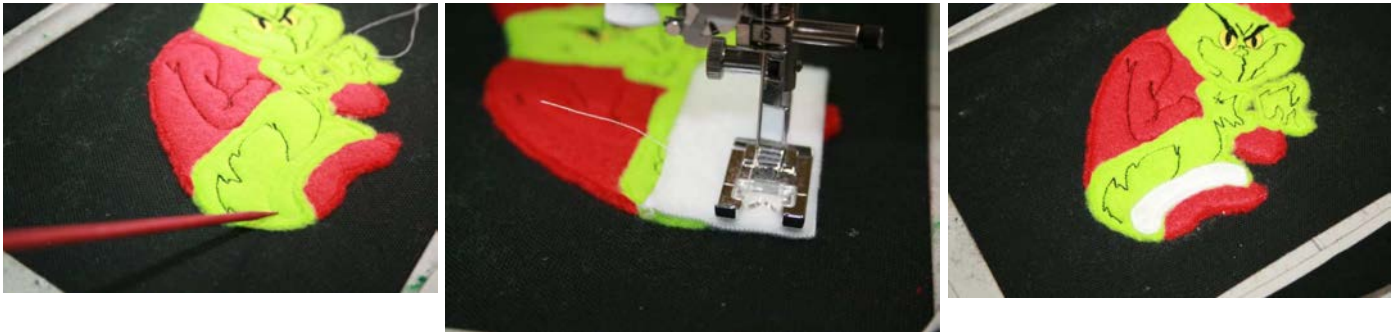
If desired Stop embroidery here and sew fluff trim of your choice to the jacket, hat and shoe. If you want to complete the applique, continue the design.



Change Thread Color To White to stitch fluff



Steps 17 and 18— White Thread—Placement stitch, Use Piece H, Tack down, Trim around fabric



Steps 19 and 20— White Thread—Placement stitch, Use Piece I, Tack down, Trim around fabric



Steps 21 and 22— White Thread—Placement stitch, Use Piece J, Tack down, Trim around fabric



Steps 23 and 24– White Thread—Placement stitch, Use Piece K, Tack down, Trim around fabric



Steps 25 and 26– White Thread—Placement stitch, Use Piece L, Tack down, Trim around fabric



Steps 27 and 28– White Thread—Placement stitch, Use Piece M, Tack down, Trim around fabric



If you are not adding text, your project is done stitching. Remove it from your hoop and tear off the stabilizer



Gather the chenille or brass brush to fluff the edges. If you don't have a brush, the edge of a dull pair of scissors will work also. Be careful not to cut the fabric.



Gently go over the fabric edges with the bristles and add as much fluff as you want. Use the lint roller to clean up any residual threads.
